Important Instructions

- 1. Check the admit card carefully and bring discrepancies, if any, to the notices of the APPSC immediately.
- 2. Bring the Admit Card (print out) each session to secure admission to Examination Hall. Admit Card must be preserved till the declaration of the final results of examinations.
- 3. You are to reach the Examination center/venue as given above at last an hour before the Schedule of the examination.
- 4. Your candidature has been accepted provisionally and it will be subject to production of original certificate at the time of interview/viva-voce test.
- 5. In the event of an information being found false or incorrect before, during and after this examination, your candidature for the post of JE (CIVIL) UNDER RWD will be cancelled at any stage of examination process.
- 6. Entry into the examination venue shall be closed 10 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination i.e. 8:50 A.M forenoon session.
- 7. Mobile phone, electronic gadgets Wrist watch and other objectionable article will not be allowed in the examination hall, The Commission will not be responsible for any loss in this regard. Resorting to any type of unfair means/impersonation etc, in the Examination Hall shall render rejection of your candidature and you shall be handed over to the police on duty for registration of a case against you.
- 8. The candidate will not be allowed to take away question paper till completion of examination time given.
- 9. The Commission reserves the right to amend, revise and reissue these instructions at any time during the Examination process.
- 10. For General/Non-APST candidates this admit card may be used as one time permit to entry through the checkgates at Banderdewa, Hollongi and Gumto.

Instructions For Candidates

- 1. Candidate must note that his /her admission to the examination is purely provisional and if his/her ineligibility is detected at any stage he/she will not be allowed to take examination or called for inter-view or recommended for appointment even if he/she has appeared at the examination/interview.
- 2. The candidate should not take any objectionable articles inside the examination hall/room. IS Code,Steel Table,Graph Paper,Code/Materials are not allowed. **Non Programmable calculator is allowed in Engineering paper only.**
- 3. The candidate should carefully read and follow the instructions on the cover of his /her answer sheets/OMR sheets.
- 4. The candidate must not write his/her name on answer-sheet his/her name or anything else except the specific items of information asked for. If he/she does, will be penalized.
- 5. A bell will be rung at the beginning of the examination and at every 1(one) hour. A long warning bell will also be given 5(five) minutes before the closing time. The candidate must not continue to mark or revise his/her answers after the expiry of the allotted time. Any candidate, who is found doing so, will be penalized.
- 6. The Centre Superintendent of the examination will be the time keeper and his/her decision in this regards is final .
- 7. No candidate should leave the examination hall/room unless permitted by the Invigilator to do so. Before leaving,
 - he/she must hand over the following to the Invigilators:-
 - Answer-sheet
 - Sheet for rough work (working sheet) if any .
- 8. Smoking or taking tea etc. inside the examination hall/room is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Exchanging of pen.pencil,eraser or any other article including question and answer papers is strictly prohibited in the examination hall.
- 10. Candidates intending to go to the bathroom will be escorted by an Invigilator . Under no circumstances should a candidate go to the bathroom unescorted. While going to the bathroom the candidate should turn his/her answersheet and rough sheet upside down. He/she must not carry any examination material, e.g. Test Booklet, Answer-sheet for rough work with him to the bathroom.
- 11. No candidate will be allowed to go to the bathroom during the last 30 minutes of the examination in each session.
- 12. There should not be any writing on the admit card, OMR sample and envelope. Violation of this will be treated as cheating.
- 13. Candidate should come to examination centre in advance as there will be frisking at the gate of examination centre.
- 14. Candidate will not be allowed to leave examination hall until expiry of the full allotted time for the paper.
- 15. Wearing of mask/face cover is mandatory for all candidates. Candidates without mask/face cover will not be allowed entry inside the center.
- 16. Candidates, however, will have to remove their mask/face cover for verification, whenever required by the Examination functionaries.
- 17. Candidates may carry his/her own hand sanitizer (small size) in transparent bottle and drinking water bottle.
- 18. Candidates to follow **COVID 19 norms of 'social distancing'** as well as 'personal hygiene' inside the examination Halls/Rooms well as in the premises of the venue.
- 19. Bringing of any personal belongings(Moble phone,Wrist watch,Money purse or any other objectionable articles) are strictly prohibited inside the premises of the examination center. The commission will not be responsible for the loss in this regard.
- 20. Candidates must bring their own Black Ball Pen.
